GATHERING

WE PREPARE... Stir up your power, and come! John called people to repent, to clear the decks, to completely reorder their lives so that nothing would get in the way of the Lord’s coming. The reading from Isaiah gives the context for this radical call: the assurance of forgiveness that encourages us to repent; the promise that the coming one will be gentle with the little ones. Isaiah calls us all to be heralds with John, to lift up our voices fearlessly and say, “See, your God is coming!” We say it to one another in worship, in order to say it with our lives in a world in need of justice and peace.

LIGHTING THE CANDLE OF PEACE

In days when God's people longed for peace, Isaiah declared, "Comfort, O comfort my people, says your God. Speak tenderly to Jerusalem, and cry to her that she has served her term, that her penalty is paid, that she has received from the Lord's hand double for all her sins" (Isaiah 40:1).



We who gather today also seek comfort and peace, yet we are unsatisfied with ideas of peace that tell us to keep quiet and go with the flow. We long for real peace, true peace, just peace. **We wait as people who yearn for peace that bears the fruit of community, equity, and flourishing for all.**

We light these candles as signs of God's shocking hope and just peace. May they be beacons calling us to repent and to live the good news of Jesus Christ as we wait and watch and labor for the day when all people can gather together to worship and glorify God. Amen.

FIRST READING

Isaiah 40:1-11

The first reading is in Isaiah chapter 40, verses 1-11.

Comfort, O comfort my people, says your God. Speak tenderly to Jerusalem, and cry to her that she has served her term, that her penalty is paid, that she has received from the LORD's hand double for all her sins.

A voice cries out: "In the wilderness prepare the way of the LORD, make straight in the desert a highway for our God. Every valley shall be lifted up, and every mountain and hill be made low;

the uneven ground shall become level, and the rough places a plain. Then the glory of the LORD shall be revealed, and all people shall see it together, for the mouth of the LORD has spoken.” A voice says, “Cry out!” And I said, “What shall I cry?” All people are grass, their constancy is like the flower of the field. The grass withers, the flower fades, when the breath of the LORD blows upon it; surely the people are grass. The grass withers, the flower fades; but the word of our God will stand forever. Get you up to a high mountain, O Zion, herald of good tidings; lift up your voice with strength, O Jerusalem, herald of good tidings, lift it up, do not fear; say to the cities of Judah, “Here is your God!” See, the Lord GOD comes with might, and his arm rules for him; his reward is with him, and his recompense before him. He will feed his flock like a shepherd; he will gather the lambs in his arms, and carry them in his bosom, and gently lead the mother sheep.

SECOND READING

2 Peter 3:8-15a

The second reading in in 2 Peter chapter 3, verses 8-15a.

Do not ignore this one fact, beloved, that with the Lord one day is like a thousand years, and a thousand years are like one day. The Lord is not slow about his promise, as some think of slowness, but is patient with you, not wanting any to perish, but all to come to repentance. But the day of the Lord will come like a thief, and then the heavens will pass away with a loud noise, and the elements will be dissolved with fire, and the earth and everything that is done on it will be disclosed.

Since all these things are to be dissolved in this way, what sort of persons ought you to be in leading lives of holiness and godliness, waiting for and hastening the coming of the day of God, because of which the heavens will be set ablaze and dissolved, and the elements will melt with fire? But, in accordance with his promise, we wait for new heavens and a new earth, where righteousness is at home.

Therefore, beloved, while you are waiting for these things, strive to be found by him at peace, without spot or blemish; and regard the patience of our Lord as salvation.

The Holy Gospel according to St. Mark the 1st chapter. **Glory to you, O Lord.**

HOLY BAPTISM

I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy catholic church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and the life everlasting.

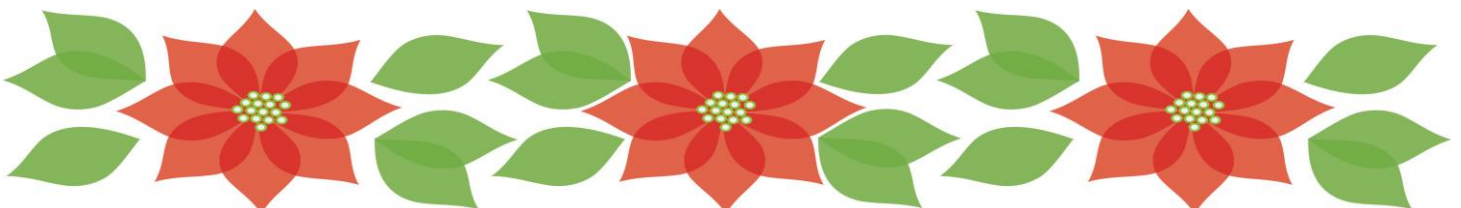

SAY, PRAY AND BLESS:

A Prayer for the Week:

Lord God, make us ready to be your messengers, preparing the way for you to come to others. Amen. (Mark 1:2-3)

Mealtime Prayer:

God our Savior, thank you for this food and all who prepared it. Help us to prepare the way for you. Amen.

A Blessing to Give:

May God be good to you. May he forgive your sins and give you his peace. Amen. (Psalm 85:2, 8, 12)

CARING CONVERSATIONS

Discuss in your household or small group:

- Have you ever been a messenger to someone? Share your memories.
- John the Baptist was God's messenger sent to “prepare the way” for Jesus. What does John's message mean to you?
- We are God's messengers, too. What message do we have to share with other people?

DEVOTIONS

If you have not already done so, set up a home Advent wreath. This week, light both the first and second candle on your wreath. In doing so, use the following words:

*The second candle on our Advent wreath is the **BETHLEHEM CANDLE**. After a long wait, the Savior that God had promised was born in Bethlehem. He was sent to bring us peace with God.*

Have a household member read Micah 5, verses 2 and 5. Then say this prayer together, repeating after the leader:

Lord God, thank you for Jesus our Savior, born in Bethlehem. Fill us with peace as we get ready to celebrate his birth. Amen.

SERVICE

We can share God's message of love with others by doing kind deeds. Using note cards or other materials, make a “road” to attach to a wall in your home. Write the words of Mark 1:3 on your “road.” As your household journeys through the second week of Advent, record any acts of service you perform on “sticky notes” and attach these notes to your “road.” Pray that your acts of service may help others to see and know Jesus.

RITUALS AND TRADITIONS

As a household, decorate and number enough envelopes for each day left before Christmas. String them on a ribbon or cord and hang it up, perhaps with a sprig of green and a red Christmas bow at each end. Place a Christmas symbol or a Bible verse in each envelope and seal it shut. Take turns opening a package each day. The anticipation will grow as the line of packages decreases and Christmas approaches.
