

### FIRST READING

Jeremiah 31:31-34

The first reading is in Jeremiah chapter 31, verses 31–34. The Judeans in Babylon blamed their exile on their ancestors, who had broken the covenant established at Sinai. Here the prophet looks to a day when God will make a new covenant with the people. There will be no need to teach the law, because God will write it on their hearts.

*The days are surely coming, says the LORD, when I will make a new covenant with the house of Israel and the house of Judah. It will not be like the covenant that I made with their ancestors when I took them by the hand to bring them out of the land of Egypt — a covenant that they broke, though I was their husband, says the LORD. But this is the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel after those days, says the LORD: I will put my law within them, and I will write it on their hearts; and I will be their God, and they shall be my people. No longer shall they teach*

one another, or say to each other, "Know the LORD," for they shall all know me, from the least of them to the greatest, says the LORD; for I will forgive their iniquity, and remember their sin no more.

**SECOND READING**

Hebrews 5:5-10

The second reading is in Hebrews chapter 5, verses 5 - 10. Using priestly imagery and references to the Old Testament, the author explains how Christ lived in trusting obedience to God, and so God has made Christ the source of our eternal salvation.

*So also Christ did not glorify himself in becoming a high priest, but was appointed by the one who said to him,*

*"You are my Son, today I have begotten you"; as he says also in another place,*

*"You are a priest forever, according to the order of Melchizedek."*

*In the days of his flesh, Jesus offered up prayers and supplications, with loud cries and tears, to the one who was able to save him from death, and he was heard because of his reverent submission. Although he was a Son, he learned obedience through what he suffered; and having been made perfect, he became the source of eternal salvation for all who obey him, having been designated by God a high priest according to the order of Melchizedek.*

The Holy Gospel according to St. John the 12<sup>th</sup> chapter. **Glory to you, O Lord.**

*Now among those who went up to worship at the festival were some Greeks. They came to Philip, who was from Bethsaida in Galilee, and said to him, "Sir, we wish to see Jesus." Philip went and told Andrew; then Andrew and Philip went and told Jesus. Jesus answered them, "The hour has come for the Son of Man to be glorified. Very truly, I tell you, unless a grain of wheat falls into the earth and dies, it remains just a single grain; but if it dies, it bears much fruit. Those who love their life lose it, and those who hate their life in this world will keep it for eternal life. Whoever serves me must follow me, and where I am, there will my servant be also. Whoever serves me, the Father will honor.*

Now my soul is troubled. And what should I say — 'Father, save me from this hour'? No, it is for this reason that I have come to this hour. Father, glorify your name." Then a voice came from heaven, "I have glorified it, and I will glorify it again." The crowd standing there heard it and said that it was thunder. Others said, "An angel has spoken to him." Jesus answered, "This voice has come for your sake, not for mine. Now is the judgment of this world; now the ruler of this world will be driven out. And I, when I am lifted up from the earth, will draw all people to myself." He said this to indicate the kind of death he was to die.

### **SCRIPTURE VERSE FOR THIS WEEK**

### **SAY, PRAY AND BLESS:**

A Prayer for the Week:

God, create a pure heart in me. Give me a new and faithful spirit. (Psalm 51:10)

Mealtime Prayer:

You satisfy the hungry heart with gift of finest wheat. Come give to us, O Saving One, the bread of life to eat. Amen.

A Blessing to Give:

May Jesus draw you to himself. May his death cover your sins, and his resurrection fill you with new life. Amen.

### **CARING CONVERSATIONS**

Discuss in your household or small group:

- Recall a sacrifice you have made for someone else. Is there something that another person has sacrificed for you?
- Jesus compared himself to a grain of wheat that would die so as to "produce lots of wheat" (John 12:24).  
What has the sacrificial death of Jesus produced?
- How is your life different because of the death of Jesus?

### **DEVOTIONS**

Read Psalm 51 as a home devotional litany. Consider dividing up the reading as follows: Reader 1: verses 1-2; Reader 2: verses 3-5; Reader 3: verses 6-9; Reader 4: verses 10-12. At the end of each section, invite all household members to respond together with these words: God, create a pure heart in me.

### **SERVICE**

Purchase flower seeds and fill clay pots with potting soil. Plant the seeds and water the soil. Plan to give the pots away as Easter gifts to friends or neighbors as a sign of the new life that has come through the death and resurrection of Jesus. You may wish to decorate the pots with Easter symbols – glue these onto the outside of the pots and paint over them with varnish.

### **RITUALS AND TRADITIONS**

This week, light five purple candles on your "crown of thorns" wreath. Read John 12:24. Then say this prayer together:

Lord Jesus, thank you for giving your life like a seed that dies so that new life could come to many. This Lent, help us to grow as wheat in your field. Amen.

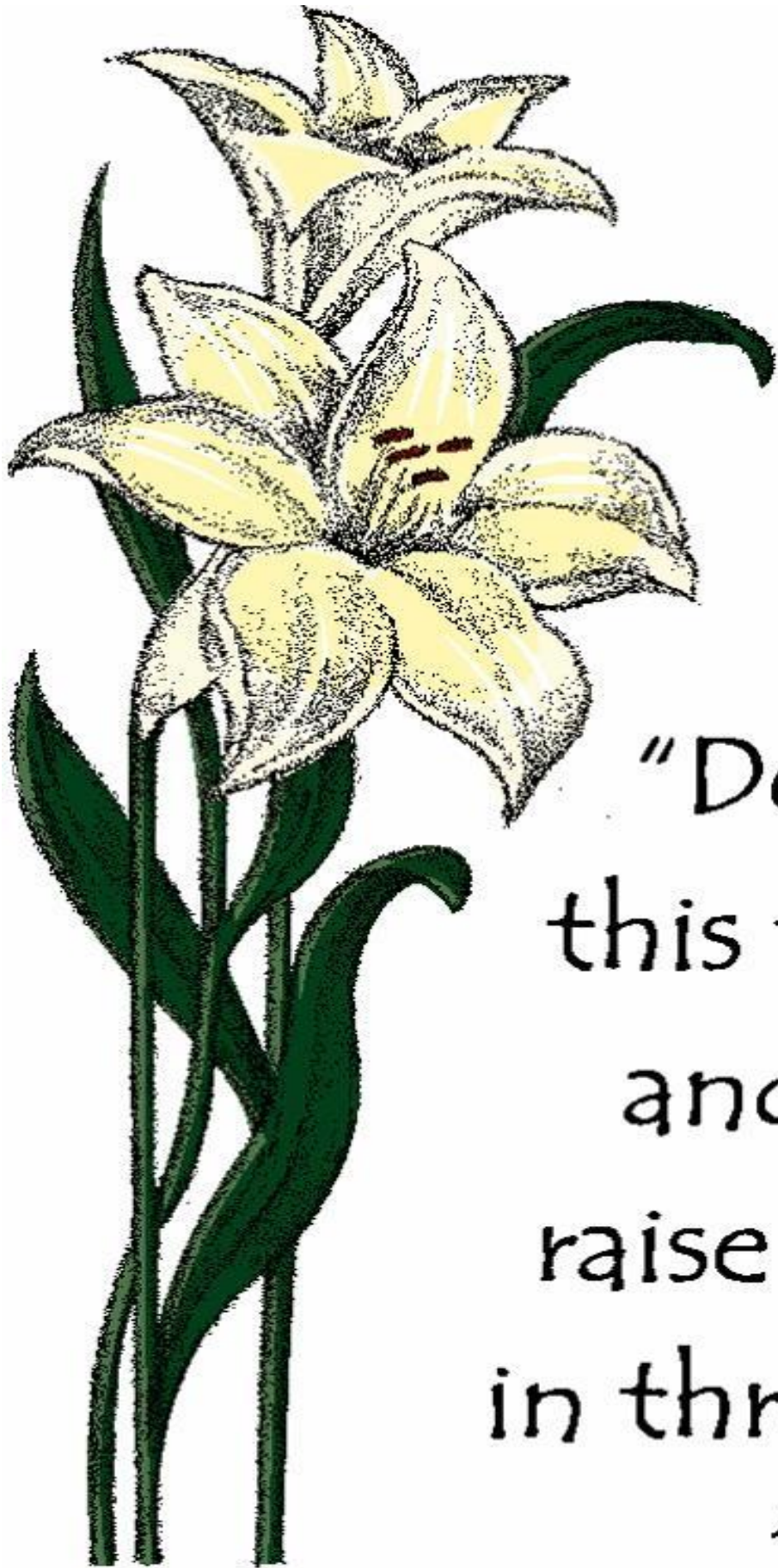
