Both Mark’s gospel and the story in Acts make clear that it is the Spirit’s movement that distinguishes Jesus’ baptism from John’s. The Spirit has come upon us as upon Jesus and the Ephesians, calling us God’s beloved children and setting us on Jesus’ mission to re-create the world in the image of God’s vision of justice and peace.*



FIRST READING

Genesis 1:1-5

The First Reading in in Genesis Chapter 1, verses 1-5.

In the beginning when God created the heavens and the earth, the earth was a formless void and darkness covered the face of the deep, while a wind from God swept over the face of the waters. Then God said, "Let there be light"; and there was light. And God saw that the light was good; and God separated the light from the darkness. God called the light Day, and the darkness he called Night. And there was evening and there was morning, the first day.

The Second Reading is in Acts Chapter 19, verses 1-7.

While Apollos was in Corinth, Paul passed through the interior regions and came to Ephesus, where he found some disciples. He said to them, "Did you receive the Holy Spirit when you became believers?" They replied, "No, we have not even heard that there is a Holy Spirit." Then he said, "Into what then were you baptized?" They answered, "Into John's baptism." Paul said, "John baptized with the baptism of repentance, telling the people to believe in the one who was to come after him, that is, in Jesus." On hearing this, they were baptized in the name of the Lord Jesus. When Paul had laid his hands on them, the Holy Spirit came upon them, and they spoke in tongues and prophesied — altogether there were about twelve of them.

SAY, PRAY AND BLESS:

A Prayer for the Week:

God of creation, make us new this day with baptismal grace. Amen. (Genesis 1:1-5)

Mealtime Prayer:

In the beginning, God made the heavens, earth and sky. For life and food and daily care, we praise you, Lord Most High!

A Blessing to Give:

May the Lord give you his strength. May the Lord bless you with peace. Amen. (Psalm 29:11)

CARING CONVERSATIONS

Discuss in your household or small group:

- What is something you have made? What did you use to make it?
- In the beginning God created the heavens and earth from nothing at all (Genesis 1:1-5).
Imagine that were you able to travel back in time to that first moment. What do you think you would see, hear, feel?
- Think back on the past week. In what ways have you seen or experienced God's creative power?

DEVOTIONS

On "Baptism of our Lord Sunday," we are invited to remember our own baptisms. In your home devotional times this week, share baptismal details and stories of members of your household. Look at any photos or videos you may have. Look up these verses about Baptism and discuss what they say: Romans 6:4, Galatians 3:27, Titus 3:5-6.

SERVICE

God calls us to help him in taking care of his creation. As an act of community service, take a few plastic bags and walk around your neighborhood picking up litter (remember to wear gloves).

RITUALS AND TRADITIONS

At the time of creation, the Spirit of God was "moving over the waters" (Genesis 1:2). The same creative, life-giving Spirit of God was present and active when Jesus was baptized in the waters of the Jordan River (Mark 1:10) and is present and active whenever and wherever people are baptized in the name of Jesus (Mark 1:8, Acts 2:38). Share a ritual of baptismal remembrance. Set out a bowl of water. Say these words in turn to each person:

(Name), you were baptized on **(date)** at **(place)**. There and then God adopted you as a beloved child and gave you the Holy Spirit. Remember today that you belong to God. *Dip a finger into the water and make the sign of the cross on the person's forehead. Then, share this blessing with them:*
May the Spirit of God move over you and in you, filling you with faith, hope, love and peace. Amen.


