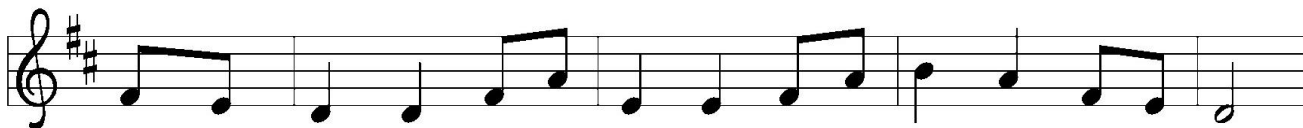

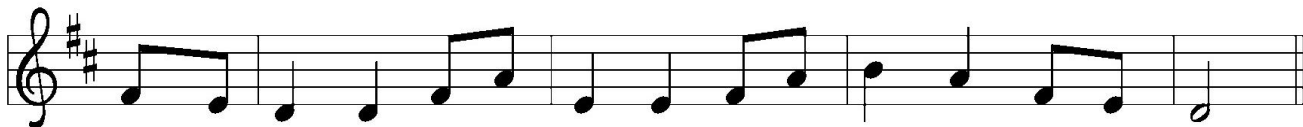

WORD

FIRST READING

Exodus 32:7-14

The first reading is in Exodus chapter 32, verses 7-14. While Moses is on Mount Sinai, the people grow restless and make a golden calf to worship. Today's reading shows Moses as the mediator between an angry God and a sinful people. Moses reminds God that the Israelites are God's own people, and boldly asks for mercy for them.

The LORD said to Moses, "Go down at once! Your people, whom you brought up out of the land of Egypt, have acted perversely; they have been quick to turn aside from the way that I commanded them; they have cast for themselves an image of a calf and have worshiped it and sacrificed to it and said, 'These are your gods, O Israel, who brought you up out of the land of Egypt!' " The LORD said to Moses, "I have seen this people, how stiff-necked they are. Now let me alone so that my wrath may burn hot against them and I may consume them, and of you I will make a great nation." But Moses implored the LORD his God and said, "O LORD, why does your wrath burn hot against your people, whom you brought out of the land of Egypt with great power and with a mighty hand? Why should the Egyptians say, 'It was with evil intent that he brought them out to kill them in the mountains and to consume them from the face of the earth'? Turn from your fierce wrath; change your mind and do not bring disaster on your people. Remember Abraham, Isaac, and Israel, your servants, how you swore to them by your own self, saying to them, 'I will multiply your descendants like the stars of heaven, and all this land that I have promised I will give to your descendants, and they shall inherit it forever.' " And the LORD changed his mind about the disaster that he planned to bring on his people.

SECOND READING

1 Timothy 1:1-12

The second reading is in 1 Timothy chapter 1, verses 1-12. The letters to Timothy and Titus are called the pastoral epistles because they contain advice especially intended for leaders in the church. Here the mercy shown to Paul, who once persecuted the church, is cited as evidence that even the most unworthy may become witnesses to the grace of God.

I am grateful to Christ Jesus our Lord, who has strengthened me, because he considered me faithful and appointed me to his service, even though I was formerly a blasphemer, a persecutor, and a man of violence. But I received mercy because I had acted ignorantly in unbelief, and the grace of our Lord overflowed for me with the faith and love that are in Christ Jesus. The saying is sure and worthy of full acceptance: that Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners—of whom I am the foremost. But for that very reason I received mercy, so that in me, as the foremost, Jesus Christ might display the utmost patience as an example to those who would come to believe in him for eternal life. To the King of the ages, immortal, invisible, the only God, be honor and glory forever and ever. Amen.

HOLY BAPTISM

In baptism our gracious heavenly Father frees us from sin and death by joining us to the death and resurrection of our Lord Jesus Christ. We are born children of a fallen humanity; by water and the Holy Spirit we are reborn children of God and made members of the church, the body of Christ. Living with Christ and in the communion of saints, we grow in faith, love, and obedience to the will of God.

I present **Hudson Jon Windschitl** for baptism.



As you bring Hudson to receive the gift of baptism, you are entrusted with responsibilities: to live with them among God's faithful people, bring him to the word of God and the holy supper, teach Hudson the Lord's Prayer, the Creed, and the Ten Commandments, place in his hands the holy scriptures, and nurture him in faith and prayer, so that Hudson may learn to trust God, proclaim Christ through word and deed, care for others and the world God made, and work for justice and peace.

Do you promise to help Hudson grow in the Christian faith and life? **I do.**

Sponsors, do you promise to nurture Hudson in the Christian faith as you are empowered by God's Spirit, and to help him live in the covenant of baptism and in communion with the church? **I do.**

People of God, do you promise to support Hudson and pray for him in his new life in Christ?
We do.

PROFESSION OF FAITH

I ask you to profess your faith in Christ Jesus, reject sin, and confess the faith of the church.

Do you renounce the devil and all the forces that defy God? **I renounce them.**

Do you renounce the powers of this world that rebel against God? **I renounce them.**

Do you renounce the ways of sin that draw you from God? **I renounce them.**

Do you believe in God the Father?

I believe in God, the Father almighty, creator of heaven and earth.

Do you believe in Jesus Christ, the Son of God?

I believe in Jesus Christ, God's only Son, our Lord, who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died, and was buried; he descended to the dead. On the third day he rose again; he ascended into heaven, he is seated at the right hand of the Father, and he will come to judge the living and the dead.

Do you believe in God the Holy Spirit?

I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy catholic church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and the life everlasting.

THANKSGIVING AT THE FONT

The Lord be with you. **And also with you.**

Let us give thanks to the Lord our God. **It is right to give our thanks and praise.**

We give you thanks, O God, for in the beginning your Spirit moved over the waters and by your Word you created the world, calling forth life in which you took delight. Pour out your Holy Spirit, the power of your living Word, that those who are washed in the waters of baptism may be given new life. To you be given honor and praise through Jesus Christ our Lord, in the unity of the Holy Spirit, now and forever. **Amen.**

SAY, PRAY AND BLESS:

A Prayer for the Week:

Create in us clean hearts, O God. Give us a new spirit that is faithful to you. Amen. (Psalm 51:10)

Mealtime Prayer:

In grace you seek us and with love you feed us. Lord, help us serve all those who need us. Amen.

A Blessing to Give:

May the God who forgives your sins and who pursues you with grace and mercy, grant you a new and right spirit. Amen. (Psalm 51:1 and 10)

CARING CONVERSATION

Discuss in your home or small group:

Share about a time when you lost something. What did you do?

Talk about a time when you were lost. How did it feel not knowing where to go?

Read Luke 15:1-10. How do people get “lost” or wander away from God? How does God pursue us when we are lost?

DEVOTIONS

In the parables of the lost sheep and the lost coin, neither the sheep nor the coin has the power to be found. A woman and a shepherd actively search out that which is lost. Repentance is often understood as our human act that says, “Next time I will try hard-er.” In Luke the emphasis is on God who befriends “sinners and tax collectors,” those who are lost (Luke 15:1-10). Biblical repentance acknowledges that we are lost and need a savior to find us. It says, “You are kind, God! Please have pity on me. You are always merciful! Please wipe away my sins” (Psalm 51:1). Reflect on ways you feel lost in your relationship to people and to God. For each thought say aloud, “**Create in me a clean heart, O God, and put a new and right spirit within me**” Psalm 51:10). End with the Lord’s Prayer.

SERVICE

Take a large garbage bag and go for a neighborhood walk. Collect as many “lost” or discarded items as you can find.

RITUALS AND TRADITIONS

Hide real or chocolate coins in your house and play a good old-fashioned game of “hide and seek.” If you use real coins, spend what you find on a treat for the household. Talk about how God rejoices when people who are lost from him return.

Work together on completing a puzzle. As you do, talk about how each piece in the puzzle is needed and has a special place. And, how, in a similar way, each one of us is valuable to God and is sought out by God. Share about the special qualities you see in one another.
