

GATHERING

WE PREPARE... The observance of the 8th day of Christmas has roots in the 6th century emphasizing "The Circumcision and Name of Jesus." Every Jewish boy was circumcised and formally named on the 8th day of his life. Already in his youth, Jesus bears the mark of a covenant that he makes new through the shedding of his blood, now and on the cross. That covenant, like Jesus' name, is a gift that marks the children of God. Baptized into Christ, the church begins a New Year in Jesus' name.

Let the same mind be in you that was in Christ Jesus, who, though he was in the form of God, did not regard equality with God as something to be exploited,


but emptied himself, taking the form of a slave, being born in human likeness.




LORD'S PRAYER



CARING CONVERSATIONS

Discuss in your household or small group:

 - How does faith in God help us when we are sad?

DEVOTIONS

While Jesus was still very young, his family fled to Egypt to escape from King Herod. There are many people in our world today who are forced to flee their homes because their countries have become unsafe for them—we call these people refugees. Find out more about refugees in our world today (e.g. look at the website www.refugeesinternational.org). Talk together about what it would be like to be a refugee and pray for those in such situations.

SERVICE

Who in your congregation or community is experiencing a time of sadness? Prepare "thinking of you" cards to send to them. Choose a Bible verse from this week's readings to insert into the cards. Children may wish to draw a picture to include with them. To remind you to pray for those who are sad, write their names onto tissues and place these in your household worship area.

RITUALS AND TRADITIONS

Psalm 148 calls on all of God's creation to offer praise. Plan a household nature outing (e.g. visit a nature reserve, the beach or a conservatory). Take a few moments to read and listen to the words of this Psalm.
