



The First Reading is in Isaiah, chapter 11, verses 1-10.

A shoot shall come out from the stump of Jesse, and a branch shall grow out of his roots. The spirit of the LORD shall rest on him, the spirit of wisdom and understanding, the spirit of counsel and might, the spirit of knowledge and the fear of the LORD. His delight shall be in the fear of the LORD.

He shall not judge by what his eyes see, or decide by what his ears hear;

but with righteousness he shall judge the poor, and decide with equity for the meek of the earth; he shall strike the earth with the rod of his mouth,

and with the breath of his lips he shall kill the wicked.

Righteousness shall be the belt around his waist, and faithfulness the belt around his loins.

The wolf shall live with the lamb, the leopard shall lie down with the kid,

the calf and the lion and the fatling together, and a little child shall lead them.

The cow and the bear shall graze, their young shall lie down together;

and the lion shall eat straw like the ox.

The Second Reading is in Romans, chapter 15, verses 4-13.





GOSPEL Matthew 3:1-12

The Holy Gospel according to St. Matthew the 3rd chapter. Glory to you, O Lord."

In those days John the Baptist appeared in the wilderness of Judea, proclaiming, "Repent, for the kingdom of heaven has come near." This is the one of whom the prophet Isaiah spoke when he said, "The voice of one crying out in the wilderness:

'Prepare the way of the Lord, make his paths straight."


Now John wore clothing of camel's hair with a leather belt around his waist, and his food was locusts and wild honey. Then the people of Jerusalem and all Judea were going out to him, and all the region along the Jordan, and they were baptized by him in the river Jordan, confessing their sins.

But when he saw many Pharisees and Sadducees coming for baptism, he said to them, "You brood of vipers! Who warned you to flee from the wrath to come? Bear fruit worthy of repentance. Do not presume to say to yourselves, 'We have Abraham as our ancestor'; for I tell you, God is able from these stones to raise up children to Abraham. Even now the ax is lying at the root of the trees; every tree therefore that does not bear good fruit is cut down and thrown into the fire.

I baptize you with water for repentance, but one who is more powerful than I is coming after me; I am not worthy to carry his sandals. He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit and fire. His winnowing fork is in his hand, and he will clear his threshing floor and will gather his wheat into the granary; but the chaff he will burn with unquenchable fire."



Christmas Food Boxes

It is time to start thinking about filling a Christmas Food Box for the families of our weekend food kids as there continues to be those in our community who are struggling to provide basic needs for their families. We are going to ask you to once again shop for a family and put items on the list in a box provided for you and return it to Trinity. You can join with another family or group to fill one or more boxes. The risk for hunger insecurity has not gone away and we at Trinity are currently feeding 31 children on weekends from 23 families. We are asking you to fill a box to be used by our weekend food families during the Christmas break when they do not have meals provided by the school.

Morning Snack Boxes

Trinity has another opportunity to help our school children this year. There is a need for snacks during morning break so if you would like to fill a box full of snacks, grab a snack box and fill that to help our students.

Here's what to do:

- 1. Sign out a Christmas food box or a morning snack box in the narthex beginning Sunday, November 20th. Put your name and phone number next to the number matching the number on your box.
- 2. Fill the box with the items from the food list.
- 3. Return your box to the table in the narthex by Sunday, December 11.
- 4. Have fun filling the box. Thank you for being the hands of Jesus!

CARING CONVERSATION

Discuss in your household or small group:

- Share about a change you have made in your life. Why did you make it?
- John the Baptist called on people to "repent" because God's kingdom was near (Matthew 3:2). What does repent mean to you?
- What is one thing about yourself that you would like God's help to change?

DEVOTIONS

In the second week of Advent, light the first and second Advent candles.

Say: This is the second week of Advent. We light our second candle to remind us that this is the season for preparing. We are preparing for Jesus to come again into our hearts, our homes and the world. (The candles are lit.)

Read: Read one of the following verses: Matthew 3:3, Matthew 3:2, Malachi 3:7, Acts 3:19, Hosea 12:6, Revelation 3:19, 1 Peter 1:13, James 5:8.

Pray: Let us pray: Lord God, in this time of preparation for Christmas, make us ready to receive Jesus. Help us turn away from sin and turn to him as our Savior. Amen.

SERVICE

Set aside time as a household to prepare Christmas cookies or treats. Using cellophane and ribbon, sort them into gift packages to give away to friends and neighbors. "Prepare the way for the Lord" by praying, by name, for those who will receive your gifts.

RITUALS AND TRADITIONS

Set up a box or empty crib under your Christmas tree. Each night have household members place pieces of straw in the crib (or yellow yarn or shredded paper strips) for kind acts done that day that help to "prepare the way for the Lord." On Christmas Eve, when the crib is filled with straw, place a nativity figure of the Christ child in the crib.
