

Where there is hostility, we long for resolution.


Let the peace of Christ rule in our hearts.

The Holy Gospel according to St. Luke the 3<sup>rd</sup> chapter. Glory to you, O Lord.



Use this simple liturgy for lighting the second candle on your Advent wreath this week:

Leader: When Jesus was born an angel appeared to shepherds with "good news of great joy." Our second Advent candle is the candle of joy. As we light it, let us cele-brate the joy that Jesus gives us. (Light two candles.)

All: Thank you, Lord Jesus, for giving us joy. Fill our home with joy this Advent. Amen.

### **SERVICE**

Look through this list of ideas for sharing during Advent. Choose one or more to put into practice this week:

- ② Look through your clothes and toys for "pre-loved" items that are still in good condition.
  - Bundle them for delivery to a local thrift store.
- Bake cookies as a family. Keep half and give the rest away.
- ② Write an encouraging note to a friend you haven't heard from in a while.

### RITUALS AND TRADITIONS

Set out a Nativity scene but without the manger and baby Jesus. Place the Mary and Joseph figures far from the Nativity, remembering that the couple is traveling a great distance to reach Bethlehem. Each day during Advent, move Mary and Joseph a little closer to the Nativity. Place the baby Jesus in the Nativity scene on December 24th or 25th.
