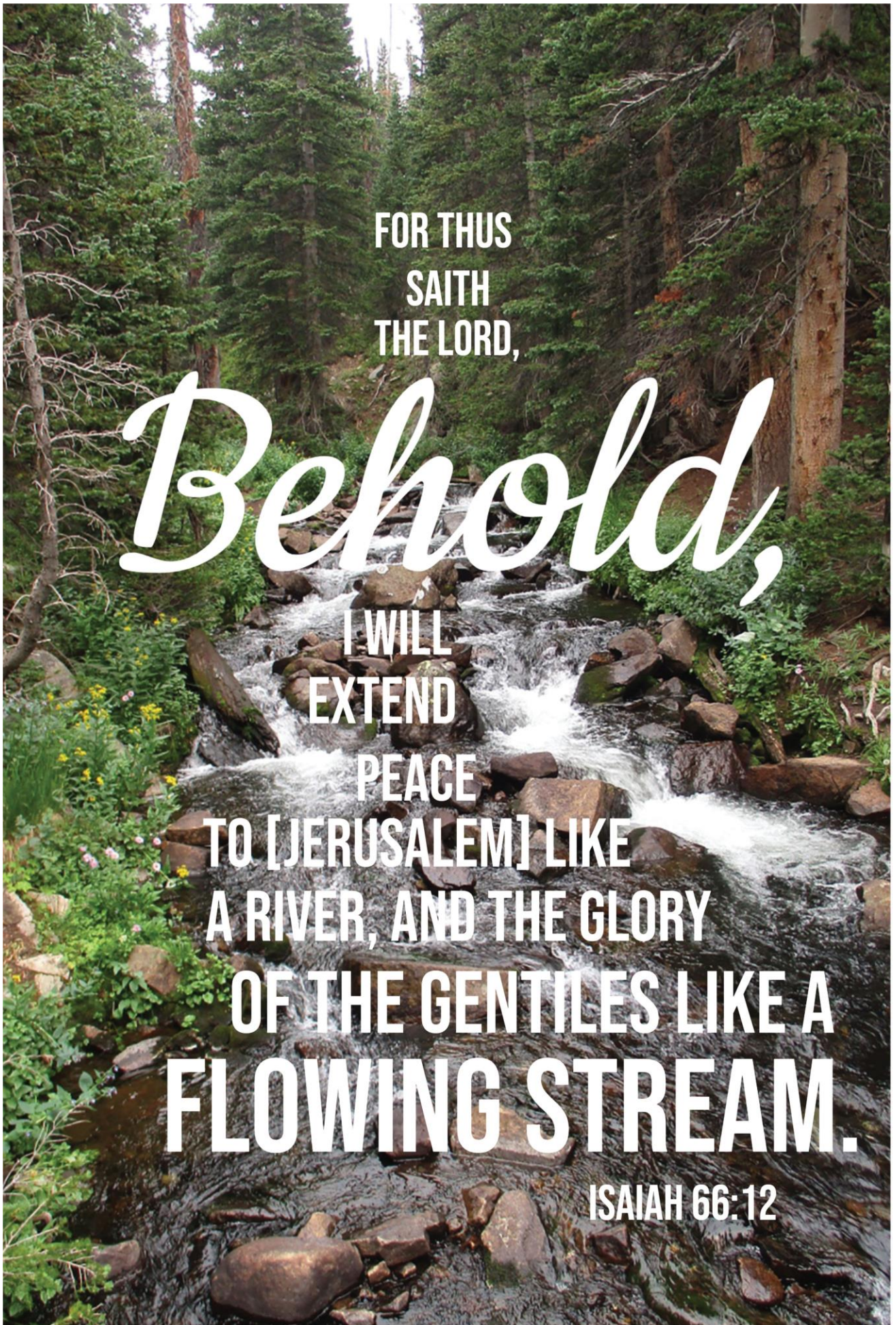

Isaiah 66:10-14

The first reading is in Isaiah chapter 66, verses 10-14.

Rejoice with Jerusalem, and be glad for her, all you who love her; rejoice with her in joy, all you who mourn over her — that you may nurse and be satisfied from her consoling breast; that you may drink deeply with delight from her glorious bosom. For thus says the LORD: I will extend prosperity to her like a river, and the wealth of the nations like an overflowing stream; and you shall nurse and be carried on her arm, and dandled on her knees. As a mother comforts her child, so I will comfort you; you shall be comforted in Jerusalem. You shall see, and your heart shall rejoice; your bodies shall flourish like the grass; and it shall be known that the hand of the LORD is with his servants, and his indignation is against his enemies.

SECOND READING

Galatians 6:1-16

The second reading is in Galatians chapter 6, verses 1-16.

My friends, if anyone is detected in a transgression, you who have received the Spirit should restore such a one in a spirit of gentleness. Take care that you yourselves are not tempted. Bear one another's burdens, and in this way you will fulfill the law of Christ. For if those who are nothing think they are something, they deceive themselves. All must test their own work; then that work, rather than their neighbor's work, will become a cause for pride. For all must carry their own loads. Those who are taught the word must share in all good things with their teacher.

Do not be deceived; God is not mocked, for you reap whatever you sow. If you sow to your own flesh, you will reap corruption from the flesh; but if you sow to the Spirit, you will reap eternal life from the Spirit. So let us not grow weary in doing what is right, for we will reap at harvest time, if we do not give up. So then, whenever we have an opportunity, let us work for the good of all, and especially for those of the family of faith.

See what large letters I make when I am writing in my own hand! It is those who want to make a good showing in the flesh that try to compel you to be circumcised — only that they may not be persecuted for the cross of Christ. Even the circumcised do not themselves obey the law, but they want you to be circumcised so that they may boast about your flesh.



May I never boast of anything except the cross of our Lord Jesus Christ, by which the world has been crucified to me, and I to the world. For neither circumcision nor uncircumcision is anything; but a new creation is everything! As for those who will follow this rule — peace be upon them, and mercy, and upon the Israel of God.

GOSPEL

Luke 10:1-11, 16-20

The Holy Gospel according to St. Luke the 10th chapter. **Glory to you, O Lord.**

After this the Lord appointed seventy others and sent them on ahead of him in pairs to every town and place where he himself intended to go. He said to them, "The harvest is plentiful, but the laborers are few; therefore ask the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers into his harvest. Go on your way. See, I am sending you out like lambs into the midst of wolves. Carry no purse, no bag, no sandals; and greet no one on the road. Whatever house you enter, first say, 'Peace to this house!' And if anyone is there who shares in peace, your peace will rest on that person; but if not, it will return to you. Remain in the same house, eating and drinking whatever they provide, for the laborer deserves to be paid. Do not move about from house to house. Whenever you enter a town and its people welcome you, eat what is set before you; cure the sick who are there, and say to them, 'The kingdom of God has come near to you.' But whenever you enter a town and they do not welcome you, go out into its streets and say, 'Even the dust of your town that clings to our feet, we wipe off in protest against you. Yet know this: the kingdom of God has come near.' Whoever listens to you listens to me, and whoever rejects you rejects me, and whoever rejects me rejects the one who sent me.

The seventy returned with joy, saying, "Lord, in your name even the demons submit to us!" He said to them, "I watched Satan fall from heaven like a flash of lightning. See, I have given you authority to tread on snakes and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy; and nothing will hurt you. Nevertheless, do not rejoice at this, that the spirits submit to you, but rejoice that your names are written in heaven."



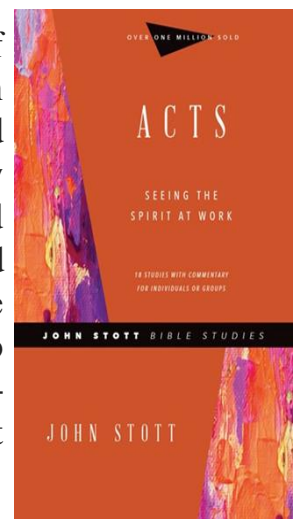

SUMMER PROJECT

For youth, ages 16-24, in need of a safe place to go, the REACH Resource Center in Mankato provides a stable, secure environment with access to basic needs like food, clothing, showers, computers, sport groups and connections to housing, counseling, employment coaching, education and other community resources. This center is a program of Lutheran Social Service of Minnesota, and needs our support.

Your Social Ministries Board is holding this important ministry up for you to consider donating needed items during the summer months. Donations may be placed in the basket in the narthex.

The following is a partial list of needed items:

Food: Fruit snacks, macaroni and cheese, canned pasta, canned soups, bottled beverages, granola bars, bottled water.

Kitchen supplies: plastic utensils, napkins, paper plates, paper towels, dish soap, cleaning supplies, paper cups, dish towels and dishcloths, foil, plastic wrap, storage bags and containers, garbage bags.

Bathroom Supplies: toilet paper, feminine hygiene products, bandages and first aid supplies, plunger and toilet bowl brush, waste basket.

Cleaning Supplies: Swiffer brand mop, broom and dustpan, sponges, hand soap, disinfectant spray and wipes, glass cleaner, bleach.

Personal Items: Wicking socks, bug repellent, sun screen.

SCRIPTURE VERSE FOR THIS WEEK

Our God, you bless everyone whose sins you forgive and wipe away.

Psalm 32:1

SAY, PRAY AND BLESS:

A Prayer for the Week:

O God, you have shown us great forgiveness. Help us to show great love. Amen. (Luke 7:47)

Mealtime Prayer:

God so gracious, God so great, we thank you God for cup and plate. Amen.

A Blessing to Give:

Blessed are you, whose sins are forgiven. Rejoice and shout for joy. Go out this day with love for God and all that God has created. Amen.

CARING CONVERSATION

Discuss in your home or small group:

Share about a time when you trusted someone to help you.

Luke 7:1-10 tells us about a Roman centurion who asked Jesus for help. Why did Jesus say this man had "great faith?"

Can you remember a time when you felt Jesus helping you? Tell your story.

DEVOTIONS

Psalm 32:1 reads, "Happy are those whose transgression is forgiven." The woman in Luke 7:36-50 expresses her joy over being forgiven by washing Jesus' feet with her tears.

Talk about the ways God's forgiveness frees your life to love God, others, and creation.

Conclude by offering this blessing to one another:

"Blessed are you (person's name), whose sins are forgiven. Rejoice and shout for joy.

Go out this day with love for God and all that God has created. Amen."

SERVICE

Ask each person in your home or small group to name a person who has shown love to him or her. Plan an act of kindness to show love in return.

RITUALS AND TRADITIONS

In the story of the woman who anoints Jesus' feet, Jesus offers a number of examples from his cultural setting of how to welcome another person into one's home. Hospitality is an important act of love and service, as well as being a Christian tradition. Consider any of the following ways of welcoming others into your home:

Greet visitors with the words, "**Peace be with you.**"

If a meal is included in the visit, light a candle and say, "**Jesus Christ is the light of the world.**"

Read and discuss a Bible passage.

Sing or pray Christian hymns or praise songs.

Ask for prayer requests and offer a prayer that ends with the Lord's Prayer.

Offer a blessing as people depart.
