

FIRST READING Genesis 18:1-10a

The first reading is in Genesis chapter 18, verses 1-10.

The LORD appeared to Abraham by the oaks of Mamre, as he sat at the entrance of his tent in the heat of the day. He looked up and saw three men standing near him. When he saw them, he ran from the tent entrance to meet them, and bowed down to the ground. He said, "My lord, if I find favor with you, do not pass by your servant. Let a little water be brought, and wash your feet, and rest yourselves under the tree. Let me bring a little bread, that you may refresh yourselves, and after that you may pass on—since you have come to your servant." So they said, "Do as you have said." And Abraham hastened into the tent to Sarah, and said, "Make ready quickly three measures of choice flour, knead it, and make cakes." Abraham ran to the herd, and took a calf, tender and good, and gave it to the servant, who hastened to prepare it. Then he took curds and milk and the calf that he had prepared, and set it before them; and he stood by them under the tree while they ate.

They said to him, "Where is your wife Sarah?" And he said, "There, in the tent." Then one said, "I will surely return to you in due season, and your wife Sarah shall have a son."


SECOND READING Colossians 1:15-28

The second reading is in Colossianss chapter 1, verses 15-28.

[Christ Jesus] is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn of all creation; for in him all things in heaven and on earth were created, things visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or rulers or powers—all things have been created through him and for him. He himself is before all things, and in him all things hold together. He is the head of the body, the church; he is the beginning, the firstborn from the dead, so that he might come to have first place in everything. For in him all the fullness of God was pleased to dwell, and through him God was pleased to reconcile to himself all things, whether on earth or in heaven, by making peace through the blood of his cross.

And you who were once estranged and hostile in mind, doing evil deeds, he has now reconciled in his fleshly body through death, so as to present you holy and blameless and irreproachable before him—provided that you continue securely established and steadfast in the faith, without shifting from the hope promised by the gospel that you heard, which has been proclaimed to every creature under heaven. I, Paul, became a servant of this gospel. I am now rejoicing in my sufferings for your sake, and in my flesh I am completing what is lacking in Christ's afflictions for the sake of his body, that is, the church. I became its servant according to God's commission that was given to me for you, to make the word of God fully known, the mystery that has been hidden throughout the ages and generations but has now been revealed to his saints. To them God chose to make known how great among the Gentiles are the riches of the glory of this mystery, which is Christ in you, the hope of glory. It is he whom we proclaim, warning everyone and teaching everyone in all wisdom, so that we may present everyone mature in Christ.

Lord, let my heart, Lord, let my heart, Lord, let my heart be good soil.



SAY, PRAY AND BLESS

A Prayer for the Week:

Lord Jesus, teach us to look to you for everything we need. Amen. (Luke 10:41-42)

Mealtime Prayer:

A Blessing to Give:

Child of God, may Jesus calm all your worries. May God give you a faith that is steady and firm. Amen.

CARING CONVERSATION

Discuss in your household or small group:

- How are the members of your family (or group) alike in personality? How are you different?
- When Jesus visited Mary's house, Martha was busy working, while Mary sat listening to Jesus. Jesus said that Mary had chosen what was better.

What do you think he meant?

• When do you set aside time to listen to Jesus?

DEVOTIONS

Jesus said to Martha, "You are worried and upset about many things, but only one thing is needed" (Luke 10:41). In your home devotion times this week, share any worries that are on your mind. Pray about these concerns, asking God to care for you and give you peace. Recite these words together from Philippians 4:6-7. "Don't worry about anything; instead, pray about everything. Tell God what you need, and thank him for all he has done. Then you will experience God's peace, which exceeds anything we can understand."

SERVICE

Two of Sunday's readings illustrate excellent hospitality. Abraham and Sarah treated their guests like royalty (Genesis 18:1-8). Mary welcomed Jesus with her undivided attention (Luke 10:38-39). Make plans to show hospitality to someone in your home. Think of someone outside of your usual circle of relatives and friends to invite to your home.

RITUALS AND TRADITIONS

Even when we are busy, we need to take time to listen to Jesus, as Mary did. If you're not in the family practice of taking a few moments each day to hear God speak to you, then try to do so this week. Decide on a time each day when all family members will be available – perhaps before or after breakfast or at dinner time. Try this simple format: (a) share about the events of the day; (b) read a short passage of Scripture or a Bible story; (c) talk about the meaning of the story or passage for your lives at the moment; (d) reflect quietly on what you have heard and conclude with prayer.
