### FIRST READING

Proverbs 8:1-4, 22-31

The first reading is in Proverbs chapter 8, verses 1-4 and 22-31. In the Bible, wisdom has many faces. It is portrayed in terms sometimes human and sometimes divine. Often, it is personified as feminine. In this passage, Woman Wisdom is depicted not only as the first creation of God but also as God's helper, rejoicing in God's creation, especially in human beings.

*Does not wisdom call, and does not understanding raise her voice?*

*On the heights, beside the way, at the crossroads she takes her stand;*

*beside the gates in front of the town, at the entrance of the portals she cries out:*

*"To you, O people, I call, and my cry is to all that live.*

*The LORD created me at the beginning of his work, the first of his acts of long ago.*

*Ages ago I was set up, at the first, before the beginning of the earth.*

*When there were no depths I was brought forth,*

*when there were no springs abounding with water.*

*Before the mountains had been shaped, before the hills, I was brought forth —*

*when he had not yet made earth and fields, or the world's first bits of soil.*

*When he established the heavens, I was there, when he drew a circle on the face of the deep,*

*when he made firm the skies above, when he established the fountains of the deep, when he*

*assigned to the sea its limit, so that the waters might not transgress his command, when he marked out the foundations of the earth, then I was beside him, like a master worker; and I was daily his delight, rejoicing before him always, rejoicing in his inhabited world and delighting in the human race.*

**SECOND READING**

Romans 5:1-5

The second reading is in Romans chapter 5, verses 1-5. Paul describes the life of faith with reference to God, Jesus, and the Holy Spirit. Even now, we have peace with God through Jesus, and our hope for the future is grounded in the love of God that we experience through Christ's Holy Spirit.

*Therefore, since we are justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ, through whom we have obtained access to this grace in which we stand; and we boast in our hope of sharing the glory of God. And not only that, but we also boast in our sufferings, knowing that suffering produces endurance, and endurance produces character, and character produces hope, and hope does not disappoint us, because God's love has been poured into our hearts through the Holy Spirit that has been given to us.*

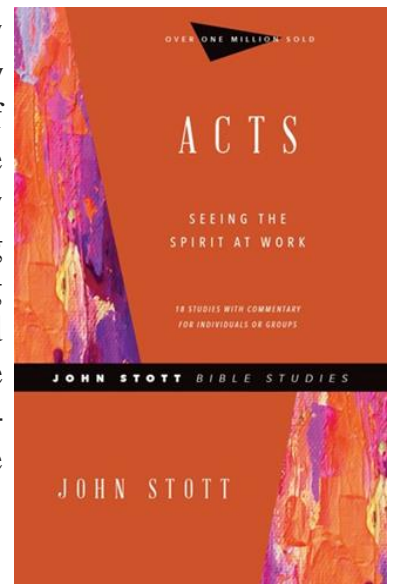

## SUMMER PROJECT

For youth, ages 16-24, in need of a safe place to go, the REACH Resource Center in Mankato provides a stable, secure environment with access to basic needs like food, clothing, showers, computers, sport groups and connections to housing, counseling, employment coaching, education and other community resources. This center is a program of Lutheran Social Service of Minnesota, and needs our support.

Your Social Ministries Board is holding this important ministry up for you to consider donating needed items during the summer months. Donations may be placed in the basket in the narthex.

The following is a partial list of needed items:

**Food:** Fruit snacks, macaroni and cheese, canned pasta, canned soups, bottled beverages, granola bars, bottled water.

**Kitchen supplies:** plastic utensils, napkins, paper plates, paper towels, dish soap, cleaning supplies, paper cups, dish towels and dishcloths, foil, plastic wrap, storage bags and containers, garbage bags.

**Bathroom Supplies:** toilet paper, feminine hygiene products, bandages and first aid supplies, plunger and toilet bowl brush, waste basket.

**Cleaning Supplies:** Swiffer brand mop, broom and dustpan, sponges, hand soap, disinfectant spray and wipes, glass cleaner, bleach.

**Personal Items:** Wicking socks, bug repellent, sun screen.

### **SCRIPTURE VERSE FOR THIS WEEK**

**We gladly suffer, because we know that suffering helps us to endure. And endurance builds character, which gives us a hope that will never disappoint us. All of this happens because God has given us the Holy Spirit, who fills our hearts with his love.**

**Romans 5:3-5**

### **SAY, PRAY AND BLESS:**

#### **A Prayer for the Week:**

Great God—Father, Son, and Holy Spirit—you are wonderful and mighty. Thank you for caring for us. Amen. (Psalm 8:1-4)

#### **Mealtime Prayer:**

Praise God, from whom all blessings flow; praise him, all creatures here below; praise him above, you heavenly hosts; praise Father, Son, and Holy

Ghost. Amen.

#### **A Blessing to Give:**

May God give you peace. May Jesus bless you with his kindness. May the Holy Spirit fill your heart with love. Amen.

### **CARING CONVERSATIONS**

Discuss in your home or small group:

What is a guide? When have you needed a guide?

Jesus told his disciples that the Holy Spirit would guide them (John 16:13). In what ways do you need God's guidance?

Tell about a time you experienced the Apostle Paul's sequence of going from suffering to endurance to character to hope.

(Romans 5:3-4)

### **DEVOTIONS**

Throughout the centuries Christians have prayed the Psalms and concluded by confessing the Trinity through the words of the Gloria Patri (Glory to the Father). This week as you pray Psalm 8 or any other Psalm, finish by saying, **"Glory to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit; as it was in the beginning, is now, and will be forever. Amen."**

### **SERVICE**

Romans 5:3-4 speaks of the sufferings experienced by Christians. Whom do you know in your congregation or community who is experiencing suffering at this time, such as health problems, grieving the loss of a friend or loved one, or having financial trouble? Plan an act of service to encourage them. Include them in your prayers.

### **RITUALS AND TRADITIONS**

For meals or for household devotions this week, begin with these words: **"In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen."** As you do so, make the sign of the cross. Here's how:

1. Bring the thumb, index, and middle finger together (representing the Trinity).
2. Touch the forehead while saying, **"In the name of the Father"**
3. Touch the lower chest while saying, **"and of the Son"**
4. Touch the one shoulder (left first for western Christian traditions, right first for eastern Christian traditions) while saying, **"and of the Holy Spirit,"** and then cross to the other shoulder. Making the sign of the cross reminds us of the grace we have received through the cross of Jesus. The four points of the cross can also signify loving God with all of one's heart, soul, mind, and body.
