REFORMATION ~ CONFIRMATION SUNDAY HOLY COMMUNION



11:00 A.M. ~ Sunday, October 31, 2021

WITH JOY IN OUR HEARTS we gather in celebration of Christ's victory over sin and death as we approach God's throne of grace where mercy and life is given to all. Today, Reformation Sunday, twelve young baptized members are making Affirmation of their Baptism in Christ. Therefore with gratitude, we honor these young saints as we recall the heritage we share in those who led the Church's Reformation over 500 years ago. It is a reformation that continues whenever we gather in the renewal and affirmation of our Baptism in Christ.

Further, we proclaim all who believe in Christ's real presence are prepared and called to receive Holy Communion. Children who have yet to be instructed in Communion are invited to come forward to receive a personal blessing.

GATHERING

WE PREPARE: On this day we celebrate the heart of our faith: the gospel of Christ—the Good News—God's gift of grace that makes us free! Though we give thanks for the events of the sixteenth-century Reformation that brought renewal to the church of that time, we also pray that the Holy Spirit would continue to unite the church today in its proclamation and witness to the world. In the waters of baptism we are united with Christ as his body in the world. Today, twelve young members are being called to make Affirmation of their Baptism in Christ and receive Confirmation from the church. As parents, sponsors, mentors, relatives, teachers and friends, we surround them with our love and prayers as we offer them our blessing, encouragement and support now and in the days that follow.

FIRST READING~ LYDIA HUIRAS

Jeremiah 31:31-34

The first reading is in Jeremiah chapter 31, verses 31-34.

The days are surely coming, says the LORD, when I will make a new covenant with the house of Israel and the house of Judah. It will not be like the covenant that I made with their ancestors when I took them by the hand to bring them out of the land of Egypt — a covenant that they broke, though I was their husband, says the LORD. But this is the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel after those days, says the LORD: I will put my law within them, and I will write it on their hearts; and I will be their God, and they shall be my people. No longer shall they teach one another, or say to each other, "Know the LORD," for they shall all know me, from the least of them to the greatest, says the LORD; for I will forgive their iniquity, and remember their sin no more.

PSALM 46~ NATALEE NACHREINER

The second reading is in Romans chapter 3, verses 19-28.

Now we know that whatever the law says, it speaks to those who are under the law, so that every mouth may be silenced, and the whole world may be held accountable to God. For "no human being will be justified in his sight" by deeds prescribed by the law, for through the law comes the knowledge of sin.

But now, apart from law, the righteousness of God has been disclosed, and is attested by the law and the prophets, the righteousness of God through faith in Jesus Christ for all who believe. For there is no distinction, since all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God; they are now justified by his grace as a gift, through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus, whom God put forward as a sacrifice of atonement by his blood, effective through faith. He did this to show his righteousness, because in his divine forbearance he had passed over the sins previously committed; it was to prove at the present time that he himself is righteous and that he justifies the one who has faith in Jesus.

Then what becomes of boasting? It is excluded. By what law? By that of works? No, but by the law of faith. For we hold that a person is justified by faith apart from works prescribed by the law.

FOR ALL HAVE SINNED AND FALL SHORT OF THE GLORY OF GOD AND ARE JUSTIFIED BY HIS CHARACTERS AS A GIFT.

GOSPEL John 8:31-36


The Holy Gospel according to St. John the 8th chapter. Glory to you, O Lord.

P: Let us pray.

Merciful God, we thank you for Kennedy, Caden, Bryent, Kadence, Lydia, Isaac, Breaunna, Envy, Jakob, Natalee, Ava, and Austin, whom you have made your own by water and the Word in baptism. You have called them to yourself, enlightened them with the gifts of your Spirit, and nourished them in this community of faith. Uphold them in the gifts and promises of baptism, and unite the hearts of all whom you have brought to new birth. We ask this in the name of Christ. **Amen.**

P: Dear friends, we rejoice that you now desire to make public profession of your faith and assume greater responsibility in the life of our Christian community and its mission in the world. In Holy Baptism our Lord Jesus Christ received you and made you members of his Church. Therefore, I ask you to profess your faith in Christ Jesus, reject sin, and confess the faith of the Church, the faith in which we baptize.

Do you renounce the devil and all the forces that defy God?

Confirmands: I renounce them.

Do you renounce the powers of this world that rebel against God?

Confirmands: I renounce them.

Do you renounce the ways of sin that draw you from God?

Confirmands: I renounce them.

(Congregation stands to affirm our faith with the Confirmands)

Do you believe in God the Father?

I believe in God, the Father almighty, creator of heaven and earth.

Do you believe in Jesus Christ, the Son of God?

I believe in Jesus Christ, God's only Son, our Lord, who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died, and was buried; he descended to the dead.* On the third day he rose again; he ascended into heaven, he is seated at the right hand of the Father, and he will come to judge the living and the dead.

Do you believe in God the Holy Spirit?

I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy catholic Church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and the life everlasting. Amen

THE PRAYERS

Let us pray for Kennedy, Caden, Bryent, Kadence, Lydia, Isaac, Breaunna, Envy, Jakob, Natalee, Ava, and Austin and for all who are affirming their Baptism in Christ this day: Let us pray for those who are affirming their Baptism, and for all the baptized everywhere:

That they may be redeemed from all evil and rescued from the way of sin and death: Lord, in your mercy, **hear our prayer.**

That the Holy Spirit may open their hearts to your grace and truth: Lord, in your mercy, hear our prayer.

That they may be kept in the faith and communion of your holy Church: Lord, in your mercy, hear our prayer.

That they may be sent into the world in witness to your love: Lord, in your mercy, hear our prayer.

That they may be brought to the fullness of your peace and glory: Lord, in your mercy, hear our prayer.

Into your hands, O Lord, we commend all for whom we pray, trusting in your mercy, through your Son, Jesus Christ our Lord.

(Congregation sits as the minister addresses the Confirmands.)

You have made public profession of your faith. Do you intend to continue in the covenant God made with you in Holy Baptism: to live among God's faithful people, to hear his Word and share in his supper, to proclaim the good news of God in Christ through word and deed, to serve all people, following the example of Jesus, and to strive for justice and peace in all the earth?

Confirmands: I do, and I ask God to help and guide me.

People of God, do you promise to support these sisters and brothers and pray for them in their life in Christ?

We do, and we ask God to help and guide us.

(Confirmands sit down)

Let us pray.

Gracious Lord, through water and the Spirit you have made these young men and women your own. You forgave them all their sins and brought them to newness of life. Continue to strengthen them with the Holy Spirit, and daily increase in them your gifts of grace: the spirit of wisdom and understanding, the spirit of counsel and might, the spirit of knowledge and the fear of the Lord, the spirit of joy in your presence; through Jesus Christ, your Son, our Lord. Amen

(Confirmands come forward on the first step in front of Pastor Tim as you are called.

Parents, Baptismal Sponsors and Mentors come forward up the middle to the Communion Rail.

After please exit to the side.)

Father in heaven, for Jesus' sake, stir up in (name) the gift of your Holy Spirit; confirm (his/her) faith, guide (his/her) life, empower (him/her) in (his/her) serving, give (him/her) patience in suffering, and bring (him/her) to everlasting life. Amen.

PRESENTATION (Confirmands all stand and face the Congregation)

Let us rejoice with these sisters and brothers in Christ.

We rejoice with you in the life of our baptism in Christ. Together we will give thanks and praise to God and proclaim the good news to all the world.

PEACE

The peace of Christ be with you always. And also with you. (You may be seated.)

MEAL

OFFERING~ KADENCE HESSE & ENVY MORALES COME FORWARD TO THE MIDDLE OF THE COMMUNION RAIL.

(The offering is brought forward by the ushers to the confirmands)

Receive the offering from the Ushers, walk up to the altar on each side of the Communion Table, bow you heads for a moment, place the baskets on the big Altar and go back to your seats.

During the music right after Kadence & Envy come back, Ava Schubbe (bread), Kennedy Braun, and Breaunna Mertz(Wine) come up the pulpit side to in front of the organ. Darlene will come with you.

Austin Uecker and Bryent Finstad go and stand by the Communion cup baskets so that you can hold them for people to use after Communion. Watch Pastor Tim until Communion begins. When finished, place them back on the stand beside you.

OFFERING PRAYER

Be known to us, O Lord, in the breaking of the bread, as you were made known to the disciples. Receive these gifts, and the offering of our lives, that we may be your risen body in the world.

Amen.

DISTRIBUTION

Come, eat, drink, and live the life God has for you.

Go down with Pastor Tim to serve Communion. Pastor Tim and Ava in the middle, Kennedy & Breaunna on each side.

Ava will say to each person as handing them the host "Body of Christ, broken for you."
Kennedy and Breaunna will say as they hand them a cup, "Blood of Christ, shed for you."

When all the people have been served, all 5 of you go back up on the altar to receive Communion from Pastor Tim and Mary. When All are finished, together, go back to your seats. Thank you!







SCRIPTURE VERSE FOR THIS WEEK

All of us have sinned and fallen short of God's glory. But God treats us much better than we deserve, and because of Christ Jesus, he freely accepts us and sets us free from our sins.

SAY, PRAY AND BLESS:

A Prayer for the Week:

Lord Jesus, thank you for the gift of faith, the power to know you and the truth that sets us free. Amen.

Mealtime Prayer:

O God, please bless the food before us, the people beside us, and the world around us. Amen.

A Blessing to Give:

May the Lord Jesus set you free. May his words live in your mind and your heart, now and always. Amen. (John 8:36; Jeremiah 31:33)

CARING CONVERSATION

Discuss in your home or small group:

Reformation means change. Talk about a time when you experienced change in your life.

Jesus says that the one who commits sin is a slave to sin. What enslaves you or keeps you from loving God and neighbor? Jeremiah 31:31-34 promises a new covenant for God's people and a time when God will remember people's sins no more. What is it like to have a God who not only forgives but also forgets?

DEVOTIONS

Reformation Day on October 31st recognizes the day in 1517 when Martin Luther posted 95 theses of belief on the doors of a church in Wittenberg, Germany. They were written to challenge the teachings and practices of the church of Luther's day.

Luther wrote "A Mighty Fortress Is Our God," a hymn that is deeply associated with the Reformation. Based on Psalm 46, it celebrates faith and confidence in God, no matter what happens around us. Pray Psalm 46 and the words of "A Mighty Fortress." List the things that are going on in your life and the world around you that challenge your faith. Then, after each of those challenges, recite the worlds of Psalm 46:1, "God is our mighty fortress, always ready to help in times of trouble."

SERVICE

The Reformation lifts up the power and grace of God's word. Bring the Taking Faith Home sheet with you on a visit to someone who is homebound.

Use portions of Taking Faith Home with that person and together experience the freeing power of the gospel of Jesus Christ. **RITUALS AND**

TRADITIONS

The beginning of the Reformation is often associated with Martin Luther's posting of 95 theses on the front door of the University Chapel in Wittenberg, Germany. Work together to write "we believe" statements on red streamers or strips of red paper. Attach these to the front door of your home in commemoration of Reformation Day.
