



"A certain creditor had two debtors; one owed five hundred denarii, and the other fifty. When they could not pay, he canceled the debts for both of them." (Luke 7:41-42a NRSV)

The season of Lent offers more opportunities for worship than at any other time of the church year. Beginning on Ash Wednesday (February 14), many congregations add a mid-week worship service to their schedules. This service is meant to be attended in addition to Sunday worship. In this worship we are to reflect on the sufferings and death of Jesus as we "rend our hearts and not our garments."

Our motivation for attending Lenten worship services comes not from "ought" and "should", but from "can" and "may". Like the debtors in Jesus' parable, we find that we have no resources with which to pay for our offenses against God and one another, for the chaos we create, for the sins we commit. We rest, instead, on the grace of our creditor, who cancels our debts and sets us free to respond in joy to Christ's love.

Giving more time to worship God during Lent is one of those response-opportunities. Embrace the call to repentance for the relief it gives, receive the offer of forgiveness for the wholeness it brings, and walk a spiritual path through Lent debt-free.

A huge thank you to the many giving units that were able to help Trinity meet the goal for receipts of \$298,000.00 in 2023. In fact, the total received was \$308,708.23! Furthermore, spending was only \$272,678.48 which helped us start 2024 with a positive balance.

At the annual meeting on January 28, the 2024 budget approved was set at \$298,000.00. This requires about \$25,000 per month in receipts to keep on track. January shows us \$4,000 behind!

Wednesday church school participants also have two goals for their weekly offerings: Food Backpack program and School and Health Kits for Lutheran World Relief. Remember to include an offering for your children when they come on Wednesday night or it can be brought on Sunday morning as well.

Some special offerings will be happening in the coming months. The **Lenten quarter folders** as well as the **Lenten supper donations** have been designated for Green Lake Bible Camp Scholarships.

The **noisy offerings** are currently being collected on the Sunday that the children sing and four non-budget items were chosen: January-March for the local Food Shelf; April-June for Green Lake Bible Camp scholarships; July-September-the Good Samaritan Fund which Trinity uses to help people who need gas, lodging etc.; October-December—ELCA World Hunger.

Look for the following items that will be in mailboxes or bulletins during February: time and talent sheets and or pledge cards. Quarter folders or film canisters will be located on the table in the back of the church for your use.

Continue to keep the financial needs of Trinity in your prayers. Thanks to Everyone who continues to serve in so many ways at Trinity.
