



# From Interim Pastor Grant...

"So they went out and fled from the tomb, for terror and amazement had seized them; and they said nothing to anyone, for they were afraid." Mark 16:8

At the end of March we will be celebrating the resurrection of Jesus. It for me is the major celebration of the Church year. Christmas is "ok" but Easter is way more special. It is the foundation of our faith and the hope for our eternal future.

The verse above is the last verse of the short ending of Mark's account to the resurrection of Jesus. Biblical scholar believe that more verses were added after verse 8 because there were just too many unanswered questions with the initial abrupt ending to the gospel.

I kind of like Mark's shorter ending to the gospel. It fits with the tearing of the heavens at Jesus' baptism, it fits with the tearing of the curtain in the Temple between the Ark and the public space. It proclaims very loudly that Jesus is now loose in world and that we can expect to encounter Him unexpectedly. God through Jesus has tore open any and all barriers. We have been given unbridled access to God and to Jesus. It also God through Jesus has unbridled access to us in how we live, in how we spread the good news of God's grace and mercy. This can be a frightening thought. Is this the reason that those who went to the tomb on that first Easter morning fled in fear? Didn't they leave Jesus hanging on the cross to die alone? Didn't their faith fail them? Now, the empty tomb, He is loose in the world, what will Jesus do?

Is fear the reason more don't step out boldly to embrace the good news of the risen Jesus? Is it that we don't know what will be asked of us, we don't know where the resurrected Jesus will lead us, we don't know what the cost will be for us to follow Jesus into the world? So then what is the purpose of faith, if it isn't exercised in our fears, our in doubts, in uncertainty?

The aftermath of Easter came at Pentecost when God poured out God's own Spirit to raise us from our fears, lead us in our doubts, and give us courage in times of uncertainty. That is where we are living now. Be of good cheer, for Jesus is risen from the dead and abides with us now and forever.

Position: Faith Formation Youth Ministry Coordinator (Part-time)





At the recent meeting of Thrivent Choice Dollars advocates, it was noted that Trinity received \$1,844 in grant money last year from members who designated their eligible money to Trinity. In 2022, Trinity received \$1,761.

These funds are kept in a non-budget account and the committee receives requests for various projects in our church and community. There is one month left before members need to sign up for the next year as April 1 is Trinity's date. Thrivent members will be receiving an announcement during the month on how to do this.

Also discussed were the Community Impact Cards that members apply for through Thrivent. Each member is eligible for two cards with a value of \$250.00. A cash card is received and is used like a credit card when purchasing items for a project. In the past a number of projects have been approved which helps out line items on Trinity's annual budget.

Some of the ways the cash cards have been used in the past are:

Devotional booklets for Lent and Advent, Shut-in baskets

New member receptions

VBS supplies, Rally Day, Confirmation banquet

Lenten suppers, Easter breakfast, youth events

Landscaping items

Coffee hour supplies and treats




